DIRECTIONS to the University of Hawaii Music Department

From Honolulu via H1

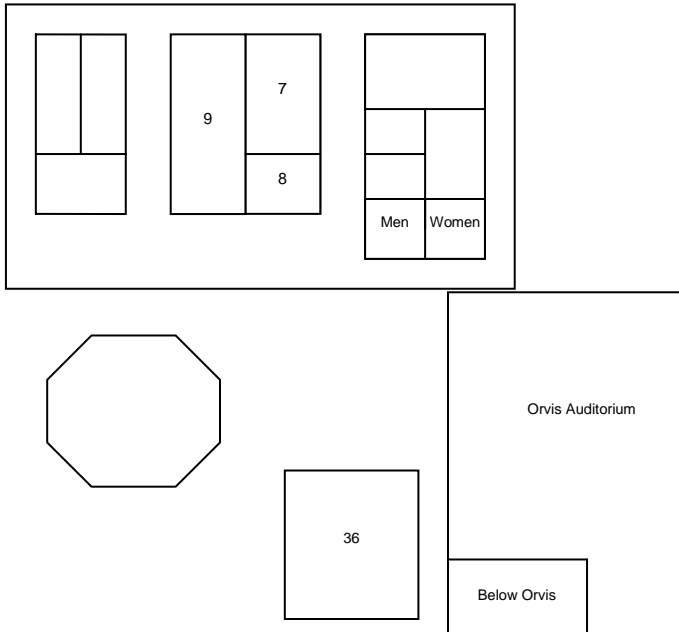
- Take the Pearl City Exit and turn right onto Moanalua Road.

From Ewa via Kamehameha Highway

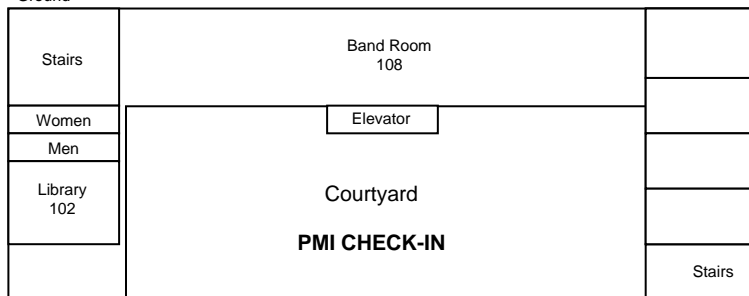
- Take the Pearl City Exit. Stay on the far left lane.

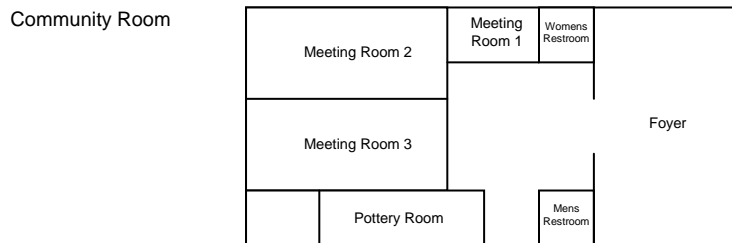
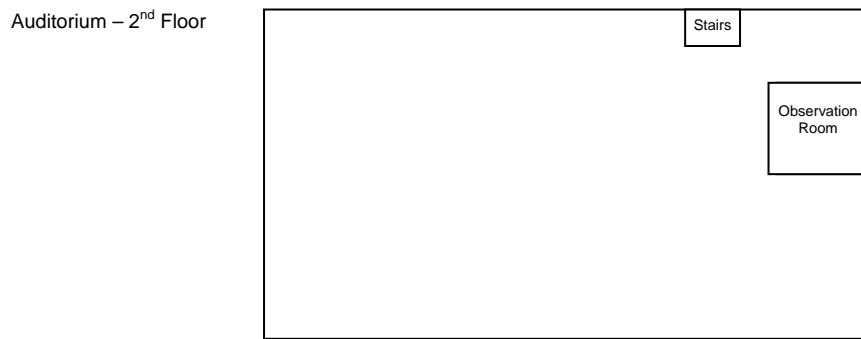
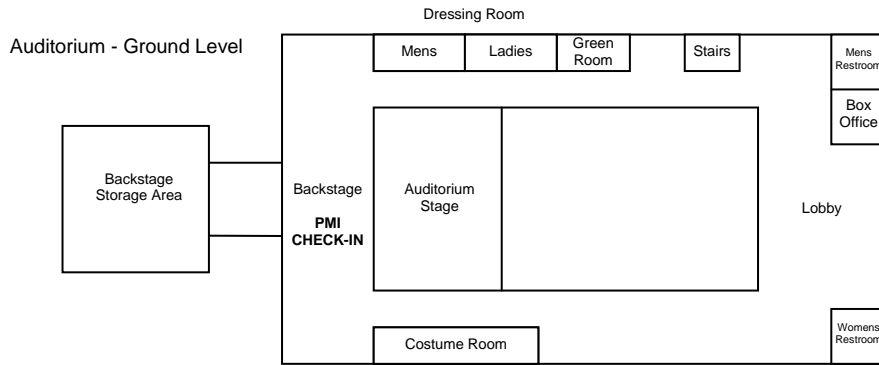
Ground

NOTES FOR STUDENT BOARDERS

Each unit comes with a shared bathroom. Two sheets, a pillow with pillowcase, blanket, wash cloths, bath towel and soap are provided. Bed linens and towels are exchanged on a weekly basis.

Coin operated washers and dryers are available on site.

HYS has paid the security deposit for each student. Should anything in the apartment be damaged or stolen, each student will be held responsible for the associated costs.

There is a remote control for the air-condition in each room. Please do not remove it. If lost, there will be a \$250 charge to replace the remote control.

There will be a \$50 charge to replace the locks of doors for all keys not returned.

If you are expecting mail, please notify the front desk. Mail can be picked up with a photo ID at the front desk after 6:00 pm daily. Outgoing mail may also be dropped off at the front desk.

MEALS FOR BOARDERS

The Housing Package includes one meal per day from Saturday, July 17 to Monday, July 26. Students will be dining in the Hale Aloha Dining Hall.

- Students will be given a numbered meal card, which they must present at the door.
- Meal cards are non-transferable and can only be used once for each meal.
- No refunds or substitutions for missed meals.
- Appropriate attire is required inside the cafeteria including footwear.
- Backpacks/bags are not allowed in the cafeteria.
- Please see a PMI or HYS staff person if your meal card is lost or stolen. The replacement fee is \$5.
- Eat to your contentment. However, do not waste or take food out of the cafeteria.

All other meals are not included in your fees. Students should bring an appropriate amount of money to cover these additional meals.
