



## 2010 PACIFIC MUSIC INSTITUTE Housing Package Information (For Off-Island Students Only)

**Cost: \$540**

The Housing Package includes the following:

- Dormitory housing at the University of Hawaii for 11 days and 10 nights (check-in July 16 check-out July 26)
- Ground transportation to and from:
  - Honolulu International Airport
  - University of Hawaii
  - Pearl City Cultural Center
  - Two dinners on July 17-18 and eight breakfasts on July 19-26 at UH cafeteria (two lunches are included in the PMI registration fee on July 17-18)

The Housing Package **DOES NOT INCLUDE** air transportation or cost of meals not stated above.

### Evening Activities

Staff, with the consensus of the group, will be planning evening activities and dinners. Attendance at these functions is mandatory. Costs for these activities (e.g. shopping, movies) will be kept nominal and are not included in the Housing Package cost. Excursions without a chaperone are *not* permitted.

Participants must adhere to all the rules and regulations set forth, for their safety, by the PMI and the University of Hawaii administrations. Please read these rules and regulations with your parents/guardians carefully, then sign the agreement, and return to HYS along with your payment.

- Chaperones will enforce PMI rules at all times. Students are expected to cooperate with chaperones, staff, and activity coordinators. In the event of non-compliance, the first offense will result in a warning. The second and final offense will result in parental contact and subsequent dismissal from PMI and the UH dormitories\*. No refund will be issued for either PMI or any unused portion of the Housing Package.
- Use of illegal drugs, alcohol, or stealing will result in immediate expulsion and forfeiture of all fees.
- Boys may not visit girls' apartments/rooms and vice versa if a chaperone is not present. A violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from PMI and forfeiture of all fees.
- Students should be in their rooms and have lights out at the time designated by the chaperones. Showers, loud talking, use of electronic devices, as well as music practice is not allowed after this time. Chaperones will perform room checks each night. Tardiness for lights out will result in a warning. A second tardy will result in parental contact. A third and final tardy will result in expulsion and forfeiture of all fees.
- Overnight guests are not permitted under any condition. Visits to adult relatives may be granted only with the express permission of the PMI administration after parents make an advance, written request.
- The PMI administration and the Hawaii Youth Symphony will not be responsible for any additional costs associated with changes in travel plans or arrangements resulting from expulsion.
