Location

Requirements

Students entering grades 8 through 12 with at least two years of instrumental experience are eligible to enroll. This institute is for serious music students.

Lodging Accommodations (Off-Island students only)

Off-Island students who need lodging accommodations must complete the PMI Housing Package Registration. The cost is \$540 in addition to the registration fee, and includes lodging and one-meal per day at the University of Hawaii campus.
